

GOT MILKED ?

House Bill 144 in 2002, sponsored by Rep. David Ure (Republican) and championed in the Senate by Sen. Howard Stephenson (Republican and President of the Utah Taxpayers Association), allows children of illegal aliens to receive “resident tuition” status. This status grants them in-state tuition rates at Utah colleges and universities — all at taxpayer expense.

HB 144 blatantly discriminates against American citizens — particularly those who achieved their status through legal and lawful means — and encourages lawlessness. An American citizen who moves away from Utah for a couple of years loses his resident status. Under HB 144, an illegal alien retains his status forever, no matter where he resides or what taxes he does or does not pay.
