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To whom it may concern,

I am writing this letter regarding Jordan Bierly, a child that has been in the office once. I spoke with Jordan's mother, Lisa Bierly on 4/3/02. I received records from Lisa on Jordans' blood sugar levels on this date for the period of 11/27/01 - 1/6/02. At this time she has requested that I give her a second opinion concerning these results. My observation is that there were 5-11 low blood sugars every week.

Persistent or frequent low blood sugars could result in poor scholastic achievement. A single very low blood sugar could result in unconsciousness, coma, or even death. The treatment of frequent low blood sugars, is to reduce the insulin or to increase the total amount of food.
