



Ms. Lewis was encouraged to work w/ mom before entering the unit & explain that mom's role is to comfort her son and help make this transition as easy as possible. Mom will be allowed to have phone conversations w/ pt. Mom should not be allowed on unit's case worker. Mother has received several mandates she must complete before pt will be allowed to return home. The next court hearing is scheduled for Oct 13th at 1:30pm. The Shelter Mother, Andrea Carroll will be coming to PCMC tomorrow at 9am to begin DM education. Andrea is an RN who does not have a current State license. Her husband has Type II DM and a grandfather has Type I DM. She states she knows quite a bit about IDDM but will most likely need dietary update. M.
