Thank you for your hand delivered letter dated January 15, 2015 regarding your Government Records Access and Management Act ("GRAMA") request. We received it on January 20, 2015.

Per our telephone conversation on January 23, we have narrowed your request to include a request for a folder or packet of communications, photographs, or other records regarding Mark Shurtleff, Julie Lund, and/or Paul Amann that may have been left with the Governor's Office sometime after September 1, 2014.

After a search of our files, no such packet or records exist that are responsive to your request.

GRAMA provides that "[a]ny person aggrieved by a governmental entity's access determination" may appeal. This includes the opportunity to appeal the denial of access to records or portions of records. You may appeal within 30 days by submitting a notice of appeal to:
