

BEWARE: Dangerous Man In This Neighborhood!



Your Property and Valuables Are At Risk!

Take Action Now to Protect Your Community!

Utah Senator D. Chris Buttars, residing at 9241 S. Lisa Avenue in West Jordan, is sponsoring legislation (SB 175) to effectively repeal Citizens' Initiative B, passed by almost 70% of the voters in November 2000. Initiative B protects innocent people from having their property confiscated by financially-motivated police and prosecutors.

Sen. Buttars' bill will eliminate powerful safeguards now in Utah law. It will do the following (as determined from review and analysis of a "protected" copy of the bill):

- ⚡ **Require a property owner to prove his innocence to regain his seized property**
(i.e. you are presumed guilty until you prove yourself innocent)
- ⚡ **Enable property to be taken from you outside a court of law**
(i.e. through a bureaucratic proceeding where many of your rights are null and void)
- ⚡ **Provide perverse incentives for police agencies to be corrupt**
(i.e. entice our police officers to wrongfully confiscate your property to increase their budgets)

Despite the fact that Initiative B was written and passed by the people, Sen. Buttars has excluded the people from involvement in his secretly-drafted legislation. In addition, Sen. Buttars has publicly demonstrated a callous indifference to some of the most critical aspects of the law and his bill.
