Utah Attorney General Mark Shurtleff and Senator Chris Buttars have combined forces to destroy Citizens' Initiative B (the "Utah Property Protection Act") passed by 69% of Utah voters in November 2000.

Initiative B protects innocent people from having their property confiscated by financially-motivated police and prosecutors. SB 175, drafted in secrecy and without citizen input, will:

- Require property owners to prove their innocence to regain their seized property (i.e. you are presumed guilty until you prove yourself innocent)
- Enable property to be taken from you outside a court of law (i.e. through a federal bureaucratic proceeding, where many of your rights are null and void)
- Entice our police agencies with perverse federal incentives to be unprofessional and corrupt (i.e. entice our police officers to wrongfully confiscate your property to increase their budgets)
